Palm Avenue, a non-medical Social Model Detoxification Program, is a 20-bed facility serving men and women in San Mateo County. Palm Avenue Detox provides a 3–7-day average length of stay, with up to 14+ days based on medical necessity and referral availability.

The program has primary goals:

- 1. To provide a safe, homelike and supportive atmosphere for persons withdrawing from the effects of alcohol and other drugs.
- 2. To provide information and referrals to a continuum of recovery services in the community.

Palm Avenue provides a 24 hour information phone line for all persons whose lives are affected by alcohol and other drug related problems. Clients who wish only to detox and not be referred into a Treatment Program are accepted, as well as clients who wish to move on in the continuum of care available. If an individual is currently in crisis, please call 911. Palm Avenue Detox is non-crisis.

A person may not be admitted for the following reasons:

- 1. Behavior that is dangerous to self, staff, or other residents.
- 2. Cannot perform activities of daily living (basic self-care).
- 3. Individual experiencing an acute mental health crisis.
- 4. Having a history of severe withdrawal, seizure, or currently has a need for immediate medical care or evaluation.
