Street Life Ministries

Street Life Ministries (SLM) is a truly unique provider of food, friendship, love, direct counseling, guidance, and support services to our homeless communities in Redwood City, Menlo Park, and Palo Alto. SLM has services six nights a week spread across three locations in the Bay Area, where it provides over 45,000 meals a year. SLM differentiates itself from other organizations that provide food by where and how we provide our meals. SLM meets people where they are at by serving food outdoors near homeless epicenters. We've found hot, home-cooked meals served in outdoor venues are less threatening than many of the normally available resources for our homeless neighbors, and this fosters a safe environment for relational connections to develop with the SLM leaders and volunteers.

Being on the streets can be lonely and isolating, but Street Life has created a healthy, cooperative Christian community at each of these gatherings through the teaching of the Word, breaking of bread, fellowship and prayer.

Additionally, SLM is unique because it places its staff and its services "in the streets and camps," where the homeless live. It reaches more homeless people directly in those street locations than traditional professional service agencies. These connections build trust for guiding homeless friends toward healthier decisions, medical assistance, detox, rehab, housing, mentorship and counseling. In addition to food and encouragement, SLM provides clothing, toiletry kits, sleeping bags, medical supplies, temporary shelter, counseling, and partners with other organizations to provide recovery services and job assistance to those in need.






Homeless To Healthy

The Homeless to Healthy program takes people currently on the street who we have relationships with, gets them into housing, and works with them to conquer their addictions and find lasting employment. After a 4-5 day stop at a detox program run by one of our partners to help them deal with any immediate drug withdrawals, they will transfer to the Street Life facility and live there. The first six months of the program are focused on helping them make important changes in their life. There are AA meetings and rehabilitation classes, as well as emotional and spiritual counseling and Bible study. Many of the people who end up addicted to substances and on the streets are driven there because of trauma, and giving them a safe environment to work through their trauma can be crucial to help create lasting change. The Homeless to Healthy program is the first faithbased rehabilitation or recovery program in the Bay Area. The Homeless to Healthy program meets a real previously unmet need and helps change lives with the transformative power of Christ. Changing lives is

an extraordinarily difficult task, but through Christ all things are possible, and we've seen first hand how through Him people can completely turn their lives around.

The next six months are primarily focused on life skills and job training. The set of

We then give the option of up to two years in a group home setting, and help all of the graduates find permanent housing.





The Mobile Clothing Closet

On the streets, clothing does not last long. It gets dirty, torn, wet, or stolen and it's difficult to launder. The SLM clothing van provides our homeless friends and at-risk population with jeans, jackets, t-shirts, shoes, socks, underwear, hats, scarves, gloves, shirts, backpacks, blankets, hygiene kits and sleeping bags. We provide 20 degree sleeping bags as well, which can be life saving on a below freezing night. Our set up using a van allows us to have one central well stocked distribution point instead of several smaller less stocked ones, and allows us to travel to where there is the most need, even directly

into camps. After severe weather we travel around offering people fresh dry clothes with no restrictions.
